In the manuscript, remove any identifying information, including author names, from file names and ensure document properties are also anonymized, use the third person to refer to work the Authors have previously undertaken, make sure figures do not contain any affiliation related identifier, remove references to funding sources and do not include acknowledgments.

## II. FORMAT

### A. List and Equations

- And so on


Numbered lists use this format:
